Degree Requirements for Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology

All Kinesiology students must complete the following core classes:

Foundations of Kinesiology
First Aid & Safety
Psychology of Sport
Motor Development/Motor Learning
Measurement and Evaluation
Kinesiology (Functional Anatomy)
Biomechanics
Exercise Physiology
Special Populations in Kinesiology
Nutrition for Human Performance

Students must also complete the university's general education requirements, which include the 46-48 hour core curriculum.

Students seeking a certificate to teach EC-12 physical education must complete the Bachelor of Science Degree in Kinesiology and complete the College of Education EC-12 Teacher Certification requirements.
